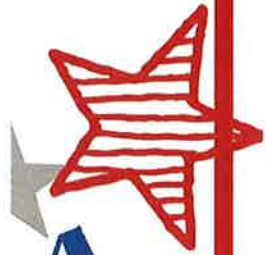
SUMMER REMINDERS.....
