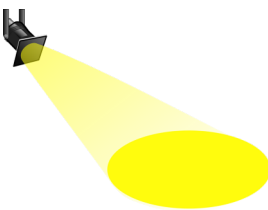

A few REMINDERS.....

- Your contact information needs to be kept up-to-date at the MHA office. If you have changes to your phone number, email address, etc., please contact Melynda at the MHA office to up-date your file.
- Porches need to be kept cleaned and ineligible items removed or MHA will remove the items for a fee billed to you.
- Summer lawn care season is here. Be sure to keep your lawn clear of toys, bicycles, BBQ grills, pet stakes, etc. MHA will pick up and throw away items left in the yard for a fee billed to you.
- Mini blinds have to be in working condition and no damage to them. To reduce damage, keep them pulled up to the top of the window and the cord wrapped around curtain rod hook or we will replace the broken blind and you will be charged. Also, repair of damages such as holes, items flushed down the toilet etc. will be charged to you.
- No pools of **ANY KIND**, water slides, etc. can be on MHA property.
- Trash must be set out on your designated trash day. If not, MHA will remove the trash from your porch or yard for a fee billed to you.
- Vehicles parked on MHA property must have current license plates and tires fully inflated. MHA follows Mexico City Ordinances.

ACHD Set To Unveil New COVID-19 Clinics Throughout County

New Model provides evening and remote access to vaccine

Starting this Thursday, residents of Audrain County still looking for a COVID-19 Moderna vaccine will have four opportunities each week to receive the vaccine. The Audrain County Health Department (ACHD) is teaming with the Missouri National Guard's Adaptable Vaccination Teams (AVT) to provide the vaccines each week, once at a location in the county and Monday through Friday at the ACHD.

"It's a novel approach being used by the state and the National Guard and we are pleased to be one of the first counties to help roll out this model," ACHD Administrator and CEO Craig Brace said. "We think by moving to smaller events and multiple days per week, we will be able to serve the population better in a more efficient manner."

The current schedule for vaccination clinics is an ACHD Routine Clinic Monday through Thursday, 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., AVT Clinic on Wednesdays at a remote location in one of the county's municipalities from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., an AVT Clinic Thursday evening from 4:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. at the health department in Mexico and an all day AVT Clinic, also at the health department on Fridays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

ACHD Routine Clinic appointments are scheduled online at myACHD.as.me or by calling 573-591-3755.

AVT Clinic appointments can be scheduled by registering in Vaccine Navigator online at covidvaccine.mo.gov/navigator, or by calling 877-435-8411.

Currently, the schedule will be:

- ACHD Routine Clinic Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at ACHD.
- AVT Remote Clinic every Wednesday through May 26th from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the following locations:

 - May 5th – Garfield Community Center, 828 Garfield, Mexico
 - May 12th – Laddonia First Baptist Church, 301 Maple, Laddonia
 - May 19th – Benton City Community Center, Benton City
 - May 26th – Farber Fire Department, 114 West Highway 54, Farber
- AVT Evening Clinic every Thursday evening through May 27th from 4:30 to 9:30 p.m. at the health department!
- AVT Friday Clinic every Friday through May 28th at the ACHD from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the health department
