MHA Property Reminders

- **Please shut and latch the new white screen doors! We want to minimize the damage to these doors and if the wind catches it and damages it, then you will be billed for the repair to fix it.**
- **Yard ornaments need to be minimized! Items MUST be up against the unit so maintenance can mow. No lights, flowers, etc. can be an obstruction for mowing or weed eating! We are not liable for damage done by our mowing or weed eating and Residents MUST be able to maintain the ornaments or they need to be removed!**
- **Trash MUST be cleaned up around your unit at ALL times!! If MHA maintenance has to remove trash from your porch or yard you will be billed \$50 each time the trash is removed! Trash cans MUST be stored on the back porch and PLEASE remember to take your trash out on your designated trash pick up day.**
- **Kids toys, bicycles, etc. MUST be picked up out of the yards or MHA maintenance will dispose of them. Bicycles and kids toys CANNOT be stored on the front porch.**

Reservations must be made at least four days in advance. Appointments should be made between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Pickup points have been established along the routes, however, the bus will deviate off-route up to 3/4 of a mile.



REMINDER

Trash and trash cans cannot be put out for pick up more than 24 hours in advance of the scheduled trash day and the empty cans must be removed from the curb within 24 hours. Mexico city ordinance states:

Sec. 32-4-Prohibited practices generally

It shall be unlawful for any person to:

- (5) Deposit residential refuse, garbage, trash or solid waste containers for pickup more than 24 hours in advance of the scheduled collection service.

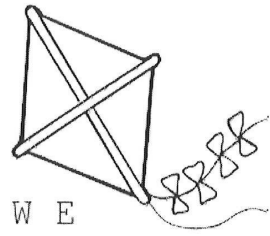
