Important MHA Lease Reminders

PETS AT MHA

A maximum number of **one** (1) domesticated pet is allowed in any unit. Domesticated pets are defined as dogs, cats, guinea pigs, caged birds, and fish aquariums no larger than twenty (20) gallons. **No animal may exceed twenty** (20) **pounds in weight.** No exotic animal or reptile shall be allowed. Residents are prohibited from feeding stray animals. The feeding of stray animals shall constitute having a pet without permission.

No vicious or intimidating pet including but not limited to Rottweiler, Chow, Pit Bull, Doberman, Pinscher, German Shepherd, or as determined by the Executive Director.

No visiting pet is allowed to reside in any unit for any given time.

Residents must obtain **PRIOR** approval of the Housing Authority by signing a copy of the pet policy, paying a pet deposit of \$100.00 and providing verification of current vaccinations with a license from the City of Mexico **BEFORE** moving a pet into their unit. Proof of current vaccinations and license from the City of Mexico will be required yearly.

Section 4.F.3 of the Mexico Housing Authority lease states:

Resident shall NOT keep pets unless prior written approval is given by MHA, in accordance with MHA's Pet Policy, which is posted in the Management Office and incorporated herein by reference.

Pet deposits ARE NOT transferable to another resident's housing unit.

The pet shall remain inside the apartment unless on a leash and directly controlled by the owner or his representative. The pet must be with the owner when outdoors on a leash or chain and the chain must be removed from the lawn area after each use.

Residents shall take adequate precautions to always maintain the unit in a sanitary condition and **eliminate** any pet odors within or around the unit. **Pet owners are not allowed to let pet droppings and waste accumulate** and are responsible for proper disposing of all pet waste. Proper disposal means placing waste in garbage bags or other sealable containers and having the materials removed with the weekly trash pickup. The pet owner shall provide and properly maintain litter boxes for cat waste.

Assistance animals are allowed with **PRIOR** approval with no restrictions other than those imposed on all tenants to maintain their units and associated facilities in a decent, safe, and sanitary manner, to refrain from disturbing their neighbors, and to maintain the health and safety of their pet(s). Therefore, a person with a disability may keep a support or service animal that is needed as a reasonable accommodation for his or her disability. A reasonable accommodation can be requested by submitting a Request for Reasonable Accommodation to the Housing Authority. The Housing Authority may verify the classification of service or companion animal to grant an exemption under MHA's pet policy.

UNAUTHORIZED GUESTS

Section Q and U of the Mexico Housing Authority lease states:

Q. Resident agrees not to allow any other person than those designated by the lease to use the address or receive mail at the resident's address.

U. Resident agrees to not house guests for more than thirty (30) calendar days per year. Resident further agrees to not house a guest for more than seven (7) consecutive days.

These are both **SERIOUS** lease violations and can lead to termination of your lease. MHA property is governed by HUD and your rent is being subsidized by them. It could be an act of fraud if you are allowing individuals that are not part of your household to reside in your home.

Mexico Housing Authority can verify with the postmaster general whether individuals are receiving mail at a Resident's address.

If MHA staff observes or receives information that an unauthorized individual may be residing in the unit, you WILL receive a warning letter to have the individual(s) removed immediately.

SMOKING AT MHA

Smoking inside all buildings and structures owned or managed by MHA is **PROHIBITED**.

Smoking outside the buildings is limited to at least 25 feet away from entrances.

Smoking means inhaling, exhaling, or breathing or carrying any lighted cigar, cigarette, hookah, ecigarette, or other tobacco product, marijuana, incense, or similar lighted product in any manner or form.

Residents will be determined to be in violation of the Smoking Policy if:

Staff witnesses a tenant, tenant's guest, family member, etc. smoking inside any MHA property

Staff witnesses a lighted smoking product in an ashtray inside any MHA owned property

Damage due to nicotine stains or burns inside any MHA owned property

Repeated reports of smoking from third parties

Cultivating/Growing marijuana plants inside or around the unit

HUD has declared that medical marijuana is considered federally illegal, regardless of state law, and considered use of an illegal drug.

Section O of the Mexico Housing Authority lease states:

Resident agrees that Resident, any member of the household, guests, or any other person under the Resident's control, shall not engage in;

2. Any drug-related criminal activity on or off MHA premises wherever located

[For the purpose of this section, drug-related criminal activity means the following:]

1. Illegal manufacture, sale, distribution, use, or possession with intent to manufacture, sell, distribute, or use, of a controlled substance, or substances commonly known as, but not limited to, cocaine, heroin, marijuana, and opium, and further defined as in the Controlled Substances Act (21 V.S.C. 802) unless such controlled substance or substances were obtained directly pursuant to a valid prescription or order.

Fire Safety and Prevention Tips:
