Brush Yard Winter Hours

Saturdays 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

The Brush Yard will change to Winter Hours the 3rd Wednesday in November. Winter Hours are Saturdays only from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. The Brush Yard will resume regular hours the first Wednesday in March.

- 1. Resident drop off only. Proof of residency needed: City utility bill, driver's license, voter ID or State issue ID.
- No material from commercial tree trimmers, landscapers, moving businesses.
- Yard waste and brush must not be mixed. No bagged yard waste.
- 4. No brush or yard waste material containing rock or gravel.
- 5. Brush and logs greater than 4 inches in diameter must be in 4 foot or shorter lengths.
- 6. Brush less than 4 inches in diameter must be in 10 foot or shorter lengths.
- Residents are to remove any bags used to transport the materials.
- 8. There will be no root wads, stumps, lumber, pallets, household hazardous waste, tires, batteries, waste oil, demolition material, asphalt, animal carcasses, construction waste, or garbage accepted at this site.
- Staff will load into a trailer but WILL NOT load into a pickup bed due to insurance risk.
