### **Job Description**

The successful candidate will:

- Exhibit a strong working knowledge of HUD rules and regulations as they pertain to Public Housing and Housing Choice Programs.
- Drive strategic planning processes and direct operational implementation thereof.
- Use capable judgement to determine when to act independently and when to seek guidance.
- Select, train, and assign personnel, delegate authority, and effect maximum efficiency.
- Oversee and safekeep MHA assets and property.
- Assure compliance with all reporting requirements.
- Serve as ex officio Secretary to the MHA Board of Commissioners.
- Comprehend complex government regulations, reports, contracts, and guidelines.
- Maintain a professional appearance at all times and promote a positive image for MHA when representing it before local civic and community groups.
- Meet performance requirements as determined by the Board of Commissioners.
- Act as a liaison between MHA and HUD and any other regulators.
- Respond to MHA and perform work related functions as required.

- Travel when position requires and attend night meetings when necessary.
- Receive and resolve complaints from staff, personnel, and citizenry.

#### Job Qualifications

The successful candidate will:

- Have earned a Bachelor's level degree from an accredited college.
- Have planned, developed, and delivered low housing management and maintenance services over five continuous years, three of which having been in an administrative capacity.
- Be bondable and possess a valid driver's license.
- Pass drug screening, criminal background, and credit checks.
