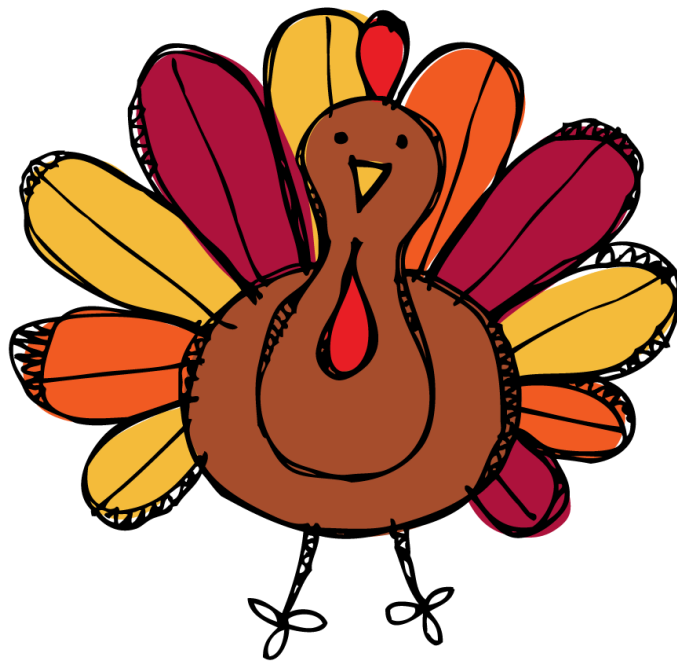

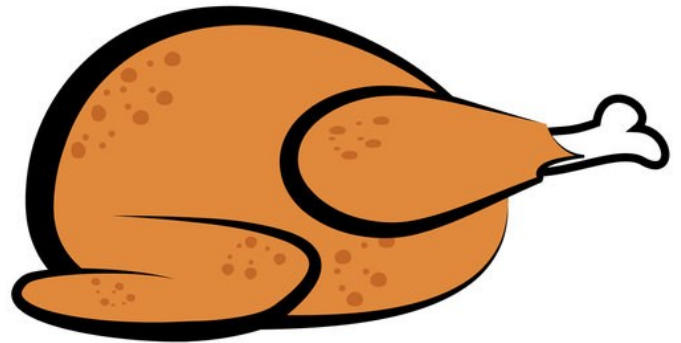


Tyronn Lue's Day of Service!

Our mission is to create strong, sustainable, inclusive communities and quality affordable homes for all.

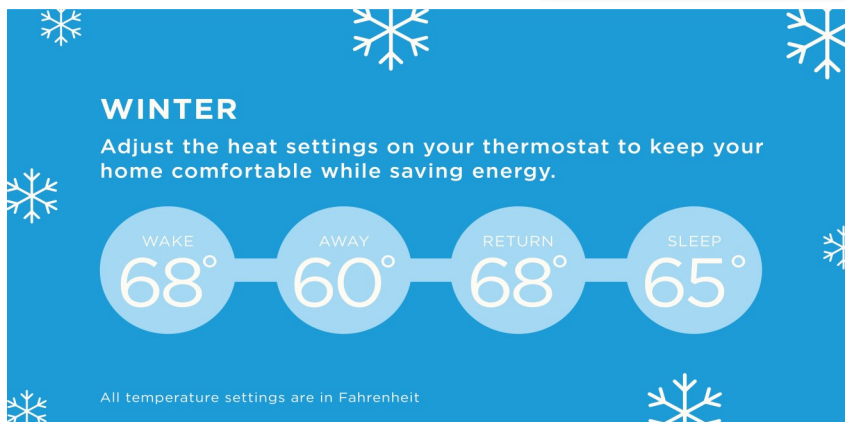
Emergency and On-Call Workorders

We are having a lot of calls for after hours workorders that are not emergencies. If your workorder is not an emergency please call the office at 573-581-2294 ext. 221 and leave a detailed message of the problem along with your address and we will promptly make sure that the issue is taken care of during business hours. Our on-call maintenance will take care of the following problems after hours:



1. No running water
2. Smoke alarm & carbon monoxide alarms beeping/missing
3. No electricity
4. Hazardous spills
5. Gas odor
6. All lights out in common areas
7. Clogged toilets/Clogged sinks
8. Welfare Checks
9. Flooding
10. Refrigerator not working
11. Lock Outs
12. No heat if temperature is below 50 degrees
13. No air conditioning if temperature is above 75 degrees

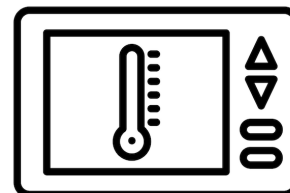
If you have further questions on how to work your thermostat or need to be shown how to use one, please contact the office!

Tips to Prevent water pipes from freezing

- Leave water faucets on at a slow drip
- Open kitchen and bathroom cabinets so warm air from inside the house can warm the pipes
- Always keep your thermostat above 65 degrees. Never turn your heat all the way off, even if you are not home
- Turn in work order request to have any holes under sinks repaired

Tips to Help Lower your Heating Bill

- Change furnace filters every month (FREE at MHA office)
- Don't block vents with furniture or objects
- Adjust thermostats 3-5 degrees, more when you're not at home
- Open blinds during the day to let sun warm your inside
- Add a few extra blankets at night to stay warm
- Do not run your AC/Heat on ON, always use the AUTO feature
