- Judging will take place from December 15th-19th!

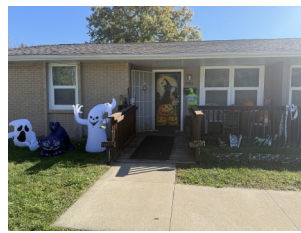
Letters to Santa!

RESOURCES IN MEXICO!

The Laura Miller Family Resource Center, situated within the main office of the Audrain County Shelter Resource Coalition at 626 E. Summit Street, Suite A is dedicated to assisting clients in navigating services to maintain their housing status. Additionally, clients are paired with an ACSRC case manager who supports them in utilizing available resources and skill-building services to stabilize their housing outlook.

The Summit Transitional Housing Program provides a secure and safe living environment for individuals experiencing homelessness but who also have income and a desire to work toward stable, sustainable, and affordable housing. The program allows individuals to build the payment history and skills needed to be per-

COLDER WEATHER!



FROZEN PIPES- Cold weather is here so please make sure to set your thermostat to stay above 60 degrees at all times. Opening cabinets under your sink and dripping water can also help prevent frozen pipes!

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE for any damage caused by frozen, bursting pipes this winter if your heat is not set at an acceptable temperature.

Home heating accounts for more than half of our monthly gas bill so here are a few ways we can beat winter and save!

Change furnace filters every month.

Don't block vents with furniture or objects.

Lower thermostats 3-5 degrees and turn off on warmer days when not at home.

Open blinds during the day to let sun warm inside of unit.

Add a few extra blankets at night to stay warm.

Winter Hours begin November 5, 2025
Wednesdays 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.
Saturdays 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Our currently posted rules are designed to reduce volume to the site so that we can provide services to Mexico City residents without having to raise refuse rates.

- Resident drop off only. Proof of residency needed: City utility bill, driver's license, voter ID or State issue ID.
- No material from commercial tree trimmers, landscapers, mowing businesses.
- Yard waste and brush must not be mixed. No bagged yard waste.
- No brush or yard waste material containing rock or gravel.
- Brush and logs greater than 4 inches in diameter must be in 4 foot or shorter lengths.
- Brush less than 4 inches in diameter must be in 10 foot or shorter lengths.
- Residents are to remove any bags used to transport the materials.
- There will be no root wads, stumps, lumber, pallets, household hazardous waste, tires, batteries, waste oil, demolition material, asphalt, animal carcasses, construction waste, or garbage accepted at this site.
- Staff will load into a trailer but will not load into a pickup bed due to insurance risk.
